All students in grades K-4 are eligible, but students who are at-risk, students not reading at grade level, and students who did not meet their NWEA reading and math anticipated growth targets over the course of the 2021-2022 school year will be targeted and given priority.

All students in grades 5-8 are eligible, but students who are at-risk or earned less than a C- in their ELA or math classes will be targeted and given priority. Students may sign up for more than one session.
