



## September 2016 – January 2018 LAKEWOOD ELEMENTARY ABSENCE DATA










Attendance to YTD-June 2017 94.78%





## DIBELS ASSESSMENT STRATEGIC PLAN TARGET 1 Academic Achievement

Percentage of students performing at or above current DiBELS Benchmark Goal, for DORF [DiBELS Oral Reading Fluency] 1<sup>st</sup> Grade = 80% 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade = 82% 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade = 83% 4<sup>th</sup> Grade = 84%

**Building-Wide = 82%** 

- Total number of students building wide performing below benchmark 87
- Students falling below benchmark are being recommended to receive interventions through ICT or TST teams.



In September we had 114 students performing below grade level benchmarks, with 77% of students building wide performing at or above DiBELS benchmark goals. We have increased our DiBELS benchmark performance by 5% from September to January.







## 3RD GRADE M-STEP, MATH






## 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE M-STEP, ELA






