

- Large capital expenses and safety needs



Capital recovery & reinvestment program






- Reinvest Money you would already be sending to your utility providers, back into your facilities

Business Case: Identify scope opportunities & quantify the estimated savings impact. *COMPLETED*

Public Procurement (RFP): Select an ESCO to design, implement & guarantee performance of performance contract. <u>2 weeks</u>

IGA Agreement **Investment Grade Audit (Design):** Finalize scope, savings, cost and funding method(s). <u>~4-5 months depending on scope</u>

Construction Contract & Finance Agreement(s)

Construction: ESCO will manage entire implementation. <u>TBD</u>

Guarantee Partnership: Training, support services and measurement and verification of savings. <u>Beginning post-install</u>
