Dear Parents and Guardians,

Tonight, the Governor ordered all K-12 schools closed beginning Monday, March 16, 2020 through April 5, 2020. However, late yesterday, we learned that there was a staff member in our high school who was put on 24-hour quarantine pending the outcome of testing for COVID-19. Due to the backlog at the testing facilities, we have not received any results as of tonight. Rather than take a chance, we are going to be proactive and cancel school beginning tomorrow. At this point, school will resume Monday, April 13, 2020 (after spring break). I will communicate later this weekend with updates.

High school students may come and pick up items between noon and 2:00 PM tomorrow (3/12/2020). Parents of our K-8 may come and pick up items between noon and 2:00 PM.
