Parents:

I'm writing with a brief update on the steps the District has taken during this bizarre heat wave.

The heat issue was thoroughly reviewed starting last week with the onset of higher-than-average temperatures. Elementary students were kept indoors for afternoon recesses at the end of the last week as a precaution.

Again last night, all of our air conditioning units were checked to make sure they were working properly. The units were turned up to normal operating standards last night to ensure that buildings were at proper temperatures this morning. We continue to monitor all units hourly.

Elementary students will be inside for recesses today and tomorrow. All classes will be conducted inside this afternoon as well. We will be making a decision on afternoon practices and evening events later today. Proper hydration is also being encouraged throughout our district.

Many area districts are closing early due to faltering air conditioning units or no air conditioning in their buildings. We are appreciative of the efforts of our maintenance department and very fortunate to have properly functioning air conditioning in all our buildings; however, we will monitor the systems and adjust our future schedule if warranted.
