Curriculum

Comprehensive curriculum offering 7 possible AP courses in-person: World History, English Literature and Composition, Biology, Chemistry, English Language and Composition, Computer Science Principles, and Calculus AB. Additional offerings available virtually. At this time, we do not offer Honors courses.

Vocational offerings include half day CTE programs, Wood Shop, & 2 hour block of Construction Tech.

Beginning Spring 22 all Dual Enrollment classes will be represented on our transcript with a letter grade.
