Lakewood Return to School Parent Survey

The MI Safe Schools Roadmap (link below), which was released on June 30, requires school districts located in any region designated as being in Phase 1-3 of the MI Safe Start Plan (link below) to provide 100% remote education.

Currently, the Lakewood Public Schools, which is more than one region, is in Phase 4. If this continues, we can reopen schools for face-to-face instruction under certain requirements and recommendations. If we are in phase 5 or 6, we can offer face-to-face instruction with fewer requirements and more "normal" safety recommendations. More details regarding the specific requirements and recommendations are provided in the survey to help you respond.

Please be aware that the Lakewood Public Schools will offer a 100% online education to families that desire it. The online options we provide will allow students to remain enrolled in the Lakewood Public Schools as proud Vikings. More information will follow based on the results of this survey and our understanding of the demand for such a program.
