Breakfast & Lunch will be provided Mondays & Thursdays, June 7 - July 4
and
July 12 - August 15

Meal pickups will be for the following:

Monday pick-up - Breakfast & Lunch for Mon, Tues, & Wed
Thursday pick-up - Breakfast & Lunch for Thurs, Fri, Sat, & Sun

Pick-up times: 10:00 am thru 11:00 am

In honor of the July 4th holiday, we will not serve meals the week of July 5th.

Meal drop off/pick-up locations will be as follows:
