We had 439 cases last week (235 the previous week); and 12,315 cases total. 140 Deaths

We had **31** 0-19 year-olds test positive **(22 school-age)** two weeks ago and **51 (42 school-age)** last week. We define school-age as 5-18 years old. The biggest jumps were in the 10-14 and 15-19 age ranges. Please note that these numbers do not include probable cases.

Positivity is 29% (number of tests is increasing) and number of cases per 100,000 population is 791. We are still in the CDC "high" transmission threshold.

We are currently tracking 2 school-associated outbreaks. Most of our outbreaks expired over the break.
