333 cases for the week (291 last week); and at **7898 cases** total. 86 Deaths

116 0-19 year-olds test positive (**106 school-age**) last week and **106 (91 school-age)** this week. We define school-age as 5-18 years old. The biggest jump was in the 10-14 age range.

Positivity is 20% (number of tests is steady) and number of cases per 100,000 population is 544. Both are trending upward. We are still in the CDC “high” transmission threshold.

We are currently tracking 26 school-associated outbreaks.

To date, there are 248 confirmed breakthrough cases in Ionia County. This is out of over 25,000 fully vaccinated individuals.
