We had **276 cases** last week (224 the previous week); and **8952 cases** total. 100 Deaths

We had **34** 0-19 year-olds test positive (**32 school-age**) two weeks ago and **55 (41 school-age)** last week. We define school-age as 5-18 years old. The biggest jump was in the 10-14 age range.

Positivity is 21% (number of tests is steady) and number of cases per 100,000 population is 453. We are still in the CDC “high” transmission threshold.

We are currently tracking 13 school-associated outbreaks.

To date, there are 511 confirmed breakthrough cases in Ionia County. This is out of over 25,000 fully vaccinated individuals.
