We had **417 cases** last week (435 the previous week); and **11,163 cases** total. 123 Deaths

We had **61** 0-19 year-olds test positive (**43 school-age**) two weeks ago and **108 (80 school-age)** last week. We define school-age as 5-18 years old. The biggest jump was in the 15-19 age range. Please note that these numbers do not include probable cases.

Positivity is 24% (number of tests is fluctuating) and number of cases per 100,000 population is 791. We are still in the CDC “high” transmission threshold.

We are currently tracking 12 school-associated outbreaks.
