

Goals and Benchmark Testing for 2021-22

- No later than September 15, 2021 Goals established for Middle and End of Year
- First Board Meeting in February, 2022 – Progress report on goals and benchmark assessment scores reported to the school board and posted to transparency link on district website
- No Later than Last Day of School Year – Progress report on goals and benchmark assessment scores reported to the school board and posted to transparency reporting link on district website
- In First 9 Weeks – First benchmark in Reading and Math administered to all students K-8 and reported to parents and the department within 30 days of administering

Goal #1

At least 80% of all students grades K-8, and those within identified subgroups, will demonstrate observable growth in math and reading between the baseline September benchmark testing and May end of year testing.

Goal #2

The percentage of students achieving their projected growth targets in math and reading from baseline September benchmark testing and May end of year testing will increase 3% over their previous school year's projected growth results per grade level (K to 1st, 1st to 2nd, etc).
