ARRIVAL

School doors open at 8:27a.m. every morning. Parents are not allowed to drop students off prior to 8:27 a.m. Once students are dropped off either by parent or bus they will go to the entrance designated for their grade level. Parents may not enter the building with their child. As they enter the building, their temperature will be taken and then, if no sign of fever is indicated, they will go directly to their classroom. Once students are inside their classrooms, they may remove their mask. If a student is getting breakfast, there will be one option for a grab and go breakfast available for students, pre-ordered from the day before.

Entrance Per Grade Level (Staff & signage will be visible to assist for the first days of school.)

- 1st Grade North Entrance,
- 2nd Grade Lower EI West Entrance
- 3rd Grade Upper EI West Entrance
- 4th Grade Upper EI East Entrance

DISMISSAL

At the end of the day, the bus riding students will exit the building through their assigned grade level doors to load buses. Students who walk will be dismissed from the back gym doors. Students being picked up will be grouped with their classmates in the gymnasium and will be released from the main entrance to families. Families who are doing car pick up are asked to join the parent pick up line beginning in the South parking lot. Parents are asked to place their child's pick up number in the passenger side window and a staff member will call for the child to be released.

MEALS

BREAKFAST

If a student is getting breakfast, there will be one option for a grab and go breakfast available for students, pre-ordered from the day before.

LUNCH

Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria in assigned seating for their classroom. Each class of students will be spread across two tables side-by-side and the next class of students will be 10-15 feet away at their own set of two tables. The lunch line time will be staggered between classes.

SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL SUPPORT

- Google classroom for teachers to access tools, materials, lessons, classroom activities and new referral forms for students in need.
- Support from The Right Door the first few days of school
- Classroom lessons with Second Step curriculum
- Daily physical and emotional health check in with staff
- Calming corners (Regulation Station) in each classroom

RECESS/PHYSICAL EDUCATION

RECESS

Each student will still receive recess outside, weather permitting, with their classroom cohort. We will be splitting our current playground space into sections where cohorts of students will be assigned by class. We have developed a schedule where students will rotate through the different sections of playground or different playgrounds on a daily basis so they can experience all of the playground equipment/space and not be in the same area day after day. Students will not have to wear their mask while they are playing, but they will have to wear one while going to and from the playground.

BELL SCHEDULES

INSTRUCTIONAL BLOCKS PER DAY

[not necessarily in this order]

- Literacy** Including all elements reading & writing
90-110 minutes, 5 days per week
- Math** [60-75 minutes, 5 days per week]
- Lunch & Recess** . [35 minutes, 5 days per week
excluding half days]
- Social Studies**.... 30-40 minutes, 2 days per week
- Science**..... 30-40 minutes, 2 days per week
- Specials *** 50 minutes, 5 days per week
- Intervention**..... 40 minutes, 5 days per week
- Recess**..... 20 minutes, 5 days per week
[may be broken into multiple breaks
throughout a day]

* Specials Include PE, Fine Arts, & Technology

SPECIALS & ELECTIVES

SPECIALS CLASSES

- All students will continue to receive a 50 minute specials class per day, including physical education, fine arts, and technology
- **Physical Education** courses will take place outside unless there is inclement weather. All equipment used during each class will be cleaned in between classes.
- **Fine Arts and Technology** classes will be conducted in the designated specials classroom. The fine arts room and technology labs will be cleaned between each class. All students will be required to wear their masks in these classrooms. Students will bring their individual art supplies to fine arts class.
- Since our specials teachers will ensure proper cleaning of their room and supplies between each class, classes will wait in their own classrooms until specials teachers are ready for them and come to pick them up. This ensures no classes are waiting in the hallways to enter the specials classrooms and transitions can move quickly.

BUILDING ACCESS SPACING &

- All open houses have been cancelled for this school year. We are working on creating a schoolwide virtual tour from Mr. Carpenter to help students and families transition into the new school year with all new common areas. Classroom teachers will do a virtual open house at some point.
- Anyone dropping off a student after the start of the school day will buzz into the main entrance to share their reasoning for coming in, and a sign-up sheet will be placed in the foyer for them to sign the child in.
- Anyone picking up a child early for the day will follow the same procedures and the child will be waiting for them in the foyer at the main entrance.
- Any visitors allowed into the building will only be allowed access to the main office. Furthermore, all admitted visitors will be required to wear a mask and complete a health screening survey.
- All of the common drinking fountains and water filling stations will be turned off. Students will need to bring a water bottle from home.
- Parent volunteers will not be permitted at this time
