## HOW YOU CAN HELP.

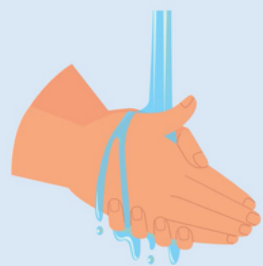
Please remember that to ensure students attend school only when they are feeling well. If your student or a household member is being tested for COVID-19, all household members, including your student, should remain home until the test results are received.
