EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Today, we had to go into a LOCKOUT due to a situation in the community.

District practices are as follows:

When we go into a **LOCKDOWN**, this situation occurs in the building, and staff and students are in classrooms and out of sight.

When we go into **LOCKOUT**, there is a situation occurring in the community, or we are creating privacy to a medical situation within the school. Students are to remain in classrooms until we end the lockout. This step is a precautionary measure to help keep our Vikings safe.

During the time we are in either situation, students will NOT be able to be removed from classrooms or let out of the school. I know this is frustrating for parents, but we are keeping everyone in classrooms and safe.


