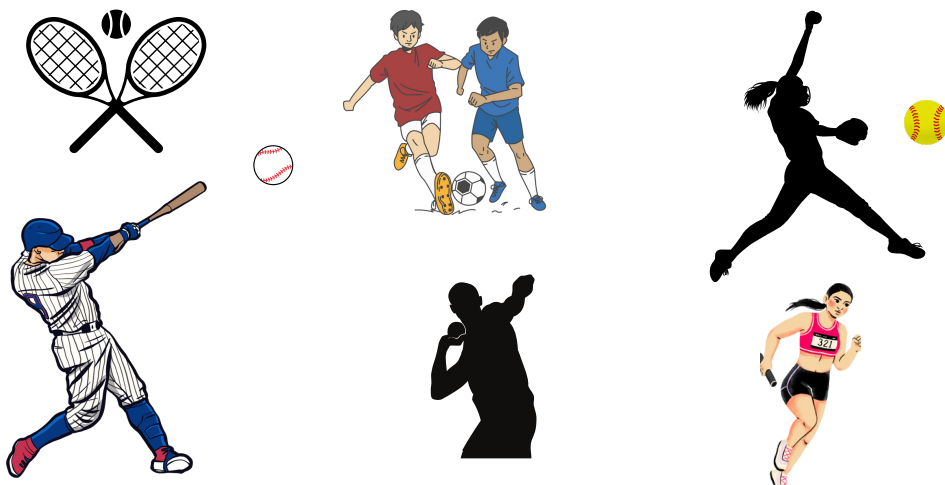

Dear Parents/Guardians & Students,

Spring is around the corner, so we are nearing our end-of-the-year state assessments. Spring Break begins on March 29 and ends on April 5. Once we return from Spring Break, we will be administering these assessments, here are the dates for each grade level.

12th Grade

April 10 - Students will not be required to attend school. However, students who did not complete assessments last year are required to complete them this year. We have contacted the students and parents of those who need to attend.

11th Grade

April 10 - Students will complete the SAT assessment. Students will be able to leave school after the completion of the assessment.

April 11 - Students will complete the ACT WorkKeys. Students will follow their class schedule after testing is complete.

April 17 - Students will complete the M-Step. This assessment will be completed in the morning and students will follow their schedules after testing is complete.

10th Grade

April 10 - Students will complete the PSAT 10 assessment. Students will be able to leave school after the completion of the assessment.

9th Grade

April 10 - Students will complete the PSAT 9 assessment. Students will be able to leave school after the completion of the assessment.

Students who are online learners are also required to report to the high school on these days to complete these assessments. Students must complete this assessment to help with their post-secondary plans. If you have questions, please contact us.
