* Attend local ethnic festivals featuring the cultures of Latin-America and Germany


STUDENT-ATHLETES

REQUEST FOR ONLINE LEARNING

Lakewood High School 2025 - 2026



It is important to the LHS Staff that all students are successful. We know that we need to meet students' needs, and sometimes that requires students to be online. Families must complete this form to apply for online classes for the 2025-2026 school year. The Principal and District Administration will review your application for approval.

To apply, students must have demonstrated successful learning in the previous semester. Submit this application before the deadline listed below. When we get to the end of the semester, we will look at each student's application to see if they have met this expectation. **Students will be permitted up to two online classes per semester.** Students who are approved to take online classes shall meet the following expectations to remain in their online classes for the 2025-2026 school year:

- > Students must meet "attendance" requirements each week. These requirements include:
 - Contact with his/her assigned LPS teacher-mentor a minimum of twice per week regarding academic/course-specific content or progress.
 - Students' attendance during the count period is required in the media center during their scheduled class hour.
 - Students must complete their grade-level-specific state assessments in the spring (April).
- > Expectations for students taking their online course(s):
 - Students are required to participate in two-way communication weekly. Two-way communication will be completed through email with an LHS teacher-mentor.
 - Students will keep up with their coursework and maintain a passing grade.
 - Students are required to come into the school on Count Days.
 - Students are required to complete all state testing.
 - Students who do not receive a passing grade may lose the ability to schedule online classes.
