Important information - AP Exams

If you have a student taking an Advanced Placement (AP) course this year. The AP program has incorporated some significant changes this year regarding when and how AP exams are ordered. New for the 2019-2020 school year:

Students must join each AP course they are enrolled in by signing in to

myap.collegeboard.org and then entering the code provided by their teacher. This should be completed by September 27th

The total cost of <u>each</u> AP exam is \$90

A \$40 deposit (per exam) is due by Friday, November 1st

There are <u>No Refunds</u> for the deposit after November 15th (The CollegeBoard will charge Lakewood Public Schools \$40, per exam fee, for any unused/canceled exams after November 15th)

The total remaining balance is due by Friday, May 1st

All money should be turned in to Mr. Knoth in the Guidance Office. Please make checks payable to Lakewood High School. <u>College Reps.</u> visit LHS to speak with interested juniors and seniors.
