Financial Report

Treasurer Dan Braker reports the following account balances

Checking - \$38,074.84

Student/Savings - \$9,160.80

Capital Improvement/Instrument - \$8,212.98

Band Camp costs were roughly \$6,000 for staff and food

Old Business

Uniform Cleaning will be staying on the agenda for the foreseeable future. Parents are not allowed in the school to pick up uniforms for cleaning.

There will be no need for uniforms this season due to competitions being cancelled by the MSBOA and invitationals being barred by the Lakewood School Administration.

New Business

A senior performance is being discussed for October.

Activity Fees

Heather Collar suggested a refund of 1/3 of the paid cost of each student due to a shortened band camp and truncated marching season.

Students who paid in cash will receive a letter detailing how to obtain their cash refund. Students who paid via Charms account will have their portions returned to their accounts. Amounts will be rounded down to the nearest dollar amount.

Heather Collar made the motion to accept, Brook Zbiciak seconded, a roll call vote was made and passed unanimously.

Concession Stand

The administration has given the Band Boosters the go ahead to open and run the concession stand.

All food and drink served must be pre-packaged, as per the school administration's requirements.

A vote to not open the concession stand passed unanimously

Adam Noaeill will inform Mr. Quinn of the Boosters decision to not open the concession stand this football season.

Fundraiser Schedule

Sponsorship Fundraiser will possibly begin September 21 and run for 2 weeks

Scrip Fundraiser will begin in time to get cards out before Christmas if not before Black Friday

There will be no sub fundraiser this year due to Covid-19

Fudge Fundraiser is a possibility, Melissa Cronk and Tonia Heath, as school employees, have volunteered to help sort and distribute fudge to students for delivery.
